## COMPETITION DETAILS

## RULES

Event is organised according to official rules of EMMA with addendum valid from 2 April, 2008. The organisers made some additions and explanations which do not contradict to official competition rules and fair play principle.

### Part 2 General competition rules and procedures

Explanation in chapter **2.1 Registration**

9. Form for preliminary registration is published on [www.emmanet.lt](http://www.emmanet.lt)

Deadline of preliminary registration: 2008-09-15

10. The registration fee has to be paid cash to the organising association, on the morning of the event:

10.1. for natural person

- ESPL Experienced 50 LTL
- ESPL Master 50 LTL

10.2. for legal person

- ESPL Master 150 LTL

Requirements of chapter 2.1 remain the same.

12. Participants of Entry, Experienced and natural persons registered in categories Advanced and Master are not allowed to promote any names, trade marks, logos in the event without preliminary harmonisation with organisers. Organisers will provide substitutes instead of registration plates.  
Other requirements of chapter 2.1 remain the same.

Explanation in chapter **2.3 On the competition day**

The competitors must be at the registration in time - from 8:00 to 9:00 (local time) 21-09-2008.

Following text remain the same.

Changes in chapter **2.4.2. National final**

For the winner of Lithuanian national final (champion) to be defined, minimum two stages must be held during one year. The Lithuanian champion will be citizen of Lithuania with the highest aggregate score after two stages. If the competitor with the highest aggregate score will be foreigner, he will be considered winner at competition, but will not become Lithuanian champion.

Lithuanian national final is two stages competition in 2008. The first stage will take place 18 May in Alytus, and the second will run 21 September in Kaunas.

Following text remain the same.

### Part 3 Categories and classes

Changes in chapter **3.7 EMMA Sound Pressure League (ESPL)**

ESPL contestants will be separated into three classes:

**ESPL Experienced 2W** standard vehicle is equipped with no more than 2 subwoofers  
**ESPL Experienced 4W** standard vehicle is equipped with no more than 4 subwoofers  
**ESPL Master** number of subwoofers used and their location unlimited

**Standard vehicle** is the vehicle which comply all the following requirements, on the day of competition:

- number of useable seats designated by manufacturer,
- one alternator connected,
- one battery connected,
- subwoofers must be mounted not higher than the top of original rear seat

Vehicle, not complying any requirement listed above, is considered as **Special vehicle** and must compete in Master Category.

Supporting team should not exceed 4 persons (contestant + 3)

Requirements of chapter 3.7 remain the same.

Changes in chapter **The following procedures and rules must be adhered to during the ESPL judging:**

3. CD to be used for the judging process is appointed by EMMA and to be announced before competition.
  4. SPL will be measured with engine running (maximum RPM 2000) and charging voltage not exceeding 14,4 Volts, except in Master category.
  12. Any person can not attend inside vehicle during SPL measurement.
  13. The Vehicles must be shown to the public before SPL measurements. The organisers will dispose an area for presentation. If the presentation does not happen the Head Judge will deduct 10 points
  24. All SPL measurements will be done with CREOS FFT Analyser and the according Microphone.
- Other requirements of the chapter remain the same.

Changes in chapter **7.1 ESPL judging**

**7.1.1. Installation-Judging:**

Installation judging will not be done.

Other requirements of the chapter remain the same.

ESPL competition will run in compliance with chapter **10.2 Optional for ESPL.**

2. Only SPL measurements will be counted in qualification round. The results will be added together. The best 8 of each class are qualified for the Final round.

Requirements of part 7 remain the same.
